

Reindeer Portrait

TIME: 40-60 min

MATERIALS

- White paper (If painting, I suggest using card stock. If using a "dry" medium, printer weight is fine.)
- Pencil
- Sharpie
- Colouring tool (paint, pencil crayons, crayons etc)
- Optionally - white crayon or oil pastel (for snowflakes)



STEPS

- Draw an oval in the middle of the page (head).
- Towards the bottom of the oval, draw a rounded circle (nose).
- Draw two smaller ovals for the eyes and add in some pupils.
- Draw two ears on the side of the head, towards the top.
- Add some antlers at the top of the head.
- Draw a neck that comes down from the head to the bottom of the page.
- Draw a scarf around the neck. Depending where the scarf sits on the page, they may have it extend downwards or out to the side.
- Trace the whole reindeer with a Sharpie.
- If you're going to be painting, now is a good time to add some snowflakes with white crayon or oil pastel. Then, when you paint overtop, they'll appear. The snowflakes are an optional step.
- Colour! You can use any medium or combination you choose.
