Picasso Frankenstein

TIME: 45-60 min

MATERIALS

- Purple or orange construction paper
- Green construction paper (two shades)
- Black construction paper
- White paper (printer paper is fine)
- Thin black marker
- Scissors & glue

STEPS



This project is supposed to be goofy, there is no right or wrong way to shape any of the features so let their creativity shine!

- Stack the two green sheets on top of each other.
- On the top one, draw a boxy shaped head.
- Holding both pieces together, cut out the head (you'll end up with two identical shapes).
- Choose one of the green sheets and cut it in half with a wavy line.
- Glue one of the smaller green sides to the other green full head.
- Cut a bit of either green for the neck.
- Glue the head pieces and the neck to the purple background.
- Use the black construction paper to cut out shaggy hair, bolts, mouth, eyebrows and pupil.
- Use the white construction paper for the eyes and teeth.
- Glue all the facial features onto the head.
- Lastly, using a fine tipped black marker, add stitches on the head and/or neck.
